

Weekday Reopening of Rye Presbyterian April 2021

At this time, the church offices and building are open in a limited way. While it remains wise for as much church business as possible to be conducted on the phone, Zoom, or email, you may have need to come to the church building. We request that you visit the church only if you are healthy, are showing no signs or symptoms of illness, and have not had any known exposure to COVID-19 in the preceding two weeks. If you do come to the church, please take careful note of the guidelines that are in place so that we may all safely use the church building together.

Individual Visits:

- Only one door will be open for entry – the door facing Parsons Street near the Assembly Room.
- For now, this door will be open from 10-3, Monday through Friday. If you need access to the building at some other time during the day, please contact the church office at 967-0842, or at rpc@ryepc.com.
- When you enter, you will find a station where you will be asked to do several things:
 - Sign in to the Visitor Log with your name, contact information, time of your entry (and departure), your destination in the church, and confirming your good health status. By signing in to the log you are agreeing to the waiver found at bottom of the log-in sheet.
 - If you did not bring one with you, face masks will be available at the door. You must wear a mask throughout your visit. Please ensure that your face mask is covering both your nose and mouth.
 - Please use the hand sanitizer available at the station.
- Please keep at least a 6 foot distance from all others during your time in the church.

Group Meetings

- With precautions in place, group meetings may be held at the church.
