RPC Sunday School & Childcare Reopening Plan and Guidelines (As of 9/07/2021)

This is the plan for reopening Sunday School and Childcare. The guidelines outlined here are for September/October and will be revised and updated as circumstances warrant.

- Registration: Sunday School is open to all children PreK (age 4) through Middle School. Childcare is available for infants and children under age 4. Contact Rev. JP (<u>imarshall@ryepc.com</u>) or go to the church's <u>website</u> to register your child(ren) for the 2021-22 school year.
- Location: Sunday School will be in the RPNS classrooms as in years past.
 Grade/Classroom assignments might vary from week to week. Middle Schoolers will meet in the Youth Rooms for Sunday School. Childcare will be on the first floor of the RPNS building.
- 3. **Safety Protocols:** *Masks are required* for all children and adults, regardless of vaccination status. Students and teachers will *sanitize their hands* when entering the classroom. Everyone will be seated at least *3 ft. apart*. For Childcare, masks will be worn by caregivers and children over the age of 2, and every effort will be made to keep the children 3 ft. apart. All classrooms for Sunday School and Childcare will be thoroughly cleaned and windows will be kept open.
- 4. Sick/Symptoms: Please do not send your child to Sunday School if they are feeling sick, especially if they are experiencing Covid symptoms. (There will be no "Covid questionnaire.") If after having been in Sunday School, your child has a positive Covid test, please contact the church and inform contact tracers. Same guidelines apply for Childcare.
- 5. Weekly Signup: Parents must sign up their children for Sunday School each week and are highly encouraged to do so by Friday of each week so that Rev. JP knows who is coming and what the headcount is. The sign-up will be part of the weekly online registration for indoor worship. As always, parents must be in worship in order for their children to attend Sunday School. Same process applies for Childcare.
- 6. Dropoff/Pickup Procedures: After the Children's Message, children will be dismissed to their classes. Parents (masked) will escort them to the classrooms and check them in with their teachers. At the end of worship, parents will come back to the classroom to pick up their child. For Childcare, parents (masked) may drop-off their children before worship and pick them up afterwards.
